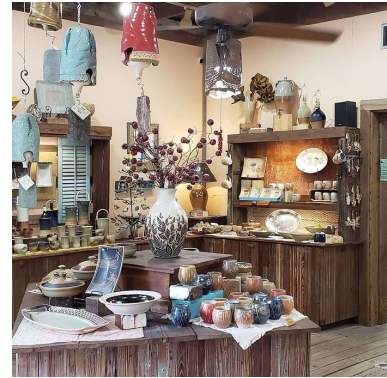
The Whites' creativity is inspired by nature. It's particularly beautiful where they live and work, and there is always new inspiration in texture and shapes right outside their door. Angie finds her vocation as a potter particularly satisfying, since it is possible to make almost anything. She uses her work like a canvas and employs a technique called sgraffito, an Italian word meaning "to scratch". Angie scratches through the surface of her pottery thereby creating beautiful designs and contrasts. You will find this technique reflected in most of their work.

At The Barn there are a variety of functional and useful pieces on display. Their pottery is crafted in their studio, which is located on-site. It is all 100% food safe and meant to be used and enjoyed. It's also important to note that their pottery is dishwasher, oven, and microwave safe as well.

We are so happy that Angie and Kyle have been part of The Empty Bowls Project for the last four years. We always look forward to displaying their beautiful bowls.
